

Responsible Party Treatment Agreement Resident Rate

The rate for residency is \$20,100.00 dollars for a (90) day stay. Arrangements to pay in monthly increments of \$6,700 at the beginning of each month can be made if I cannot pay in full at the time of admission. Payment includes resident room & board and all scheduled activities. Fees that are not included are, private counseling, medication, doctor visits, including travel to and from and resident's personal spending money. If resident leaves prior to scheduled discharge date, rate will be on a per diem basis.

I am aware that Little Creek Lodge has an adventure trek program and my son must be physically capable of participating in these activities.

I am aware that Little Creek Lodge's services are not covered by most health insurance plans. Nor do we accept insurances or give insurance codes.

Cause for termination without reimbursement

Little Creek rules and regulations are put in place to protect the resident. The following behaviors and actions will result in immediate termination.

- Drinking alcohol, using drugs, and/or having either of these or paraphernalia related to in your possession on or off premises while in residency.
- Unauthorized prescription drugs.

- Any form of physical threat or physical altercation with another resident or staff member.
- Non-compliance to program activities is cause for termination, i.e. the refusal to attend group sessions, mealtime, AA meetings or outdoor scheduled events.
- Possession of firearms, weapons, any explosive, or any other dangerous items or materials.

- Destruction of property, theft of property of the House or another resident
- Smoking or evidence of smoking in the House.

- Sexual activity is prohibited while at Little Creek.

- Gambling, cards, Internet betting, race track or book making.

- The awareness of another current resident's violation of drug use on or off Little Creek property and not coming forward with the knowledge.
- Failure to pay monthly fees could result in termination.

Little Creek reserves the right to deny residency to applicants who have a prior history of sex offense, murder, or any variation of manslaughter. This denial extends to any resident who falsifies information in their application and/or intake interview to Little Creek. Any pre-meditated or known attempts to conceal falsified information - in regard to the aforementioned criminal behavior - while a resident at Little Creek, may result in immediate residency termination without re-imbusement.
